<p>Arrival/Dismissal</p>	<p>*Parents will assess student health at home. *All staff will self-assess health at home. *Students riding the bus will be greeted by staff and brought to his/her classroom. *Parents will use door #E 15 for Ronda DeWulf and Dawn Leeseberg's classes and #E 13 for Peg DeYoung's class to drop off or pick up their child. Staff will greet the student at the door and bring him/her to classroom.</p>	<p>*All of Scenario 1</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">NA</p>
<p>Hallways</p>		<p>*Students will move throughout the building with their classroom cohort. *Students will adhere to 6ft social distancing in the hallway.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">NA</p>

<p>Cubbies</p>	<p>*Students will utilize their cubbies to allow for 6ft of social distancing (when feasible during Scenario 1). *Non-essential learning materials will be kept in student cubbies. *Teachers/teams will establish cubby/locker procedures.</p>		<p>NA</p>
<p>Classroom (includes water bottles, supplies, instruction, etc...)</p>	<p>*Students use hand sanitizer as they enter or exit the classroom or pod. *Reinforce handwashing/ sanitation during key times including but not limited to: arrival and dismissal; before, during, and after preparing or eating food: after using the bathroom; after blowing one's nose, coughing, or sneezing; after touching objects with bare hands that have been handled by other people. *Arrange classroom seating so that students are separated from one another by 6 feet when feasible. *Ensure adequate supplies to minimize sharing of high-touch materials to the extent possible (e.g., by dedicating supplies or equipment to individual students) or limit the use of supplies and equipment to one small classroom cohort group at a time, allowing for time to clean and disinfect between use. *Avoid sharing electronic devices, books, toys, and other</p>	<p>*All of Scenario 1 plans and also: *Arrange classroom seating so that students are separated from one another by 6 feet. Individual health considerations for an in-person model will be addressed.</i></p>		
Bathrooms	<p>*Teachers will establish bathroom procedures for their students using the class bathroom.</p> <p>*Students will be mindful of 6ft social distancing as feasible.</p> <p>*Students will wash hands after using the bathroom.</p>	<p>*All of Scenario 1 plans and also:</p> <p>*Students will adhere to 6ft social distancing .</p>	NA
Breakfast/Lunch	<p>*Meals, snacks and beverages served at school will be wrapped.</p>	<p>*All of Scenario 1 plans and also:</p> <p>*Students will sit 2 per table to allow for as much space as possible.</p>	<p>*Meals are available for pick-up and delivery.</p>

	<p>*Breakfast will be “grab and go” and will be eaten in the classrooms.</p> <p>*Students will sit 3 per table to allow for as much space as possible.</p>		
Health Office	*Designated area is established for a student who is showing Covid-19 symptoms.		NA
Main Office/Visitors	<p>*Non-essential visitors, volunteers, and activities involving external groups or organizations will be restricted.</p> <p>*All visitors will wear a face covering as per guidance from MDH.</p> <p>*Discontinue activities that bring together large groups of people or activities that do not allow for social distancing, including assemblies, in-person field trips, and programs.</p>		NA
Students with Special Accommodations	Students are expected to follow the same procedures set forth above for all student except when the disability or health condition prevents the student from following the procedures set forth. In that case the IEP teams or 504 Health teams will determine the accommodations or modifications needed to ensure the safety of the student and others.
