HEARD Superintendent Reopening Report- REMINDER We have Ice Cream Socials from 4-7 Tuesday and Thursday this week along with Monday next week. Our Covid numbers are growing and we are going to be constantly monitoring this number over the next few weeks.

HEARD Business Manager Reopening Report- Audit should be wrapped up next week. The levy will be approved tonight and these number are going to grow by Approx. 7000 but that could change with how things turn out with the referendum. We are looking at Cares act funding and making sure this is ready to go.

HEARD Principals' Reopening Reports-

Johnson – Everyday brings new challenges. Our mornings are very busy with all of the information we are gathering before we start everyday. Kids are doing great with mask wearing and don't need as much reminder. They are also doing great with social distancing. We started using lockers before school, after school and during lunch. We shortened our passing times back to 4 minutes which has been going well. We have a full time sub at the high school and he is great for plugging him in to fill spots. Conferences are October 7th and we are going to be using virtually as well. We are struggling with in person and distance learning teaching at the same time.

LeMier – Our kids are really falling into routine and procedures. Our Kinder conferences went very well. Our pick up and drop off a switch has been going really well. We will be doing our conferences virtually through Synergy scheduling.

Andress – We are doing well with planning and routines and procedures. We are giving ourselves breaks by going outside at 50 degrees or above. We are appreciative of the ability to go outside and remove our masks. We will also be utilizing synergy for conferences.

Stevenson – We have 12 students enrolled in the Park Rapids Area Virtual Academy. 10 in the high school and 2 in the middle school. They are touching base via google classroom, text, email and so forth.

HEARD Activities Director Reopening Report – Football and Volleyball will start up next Monday. Football will have 6 games this season and 2 post season games. Volleyball will have 14 season games and they are unsure about the post season. MSHSL has had a lot of pressure to get this going this fall. They are working on schedules, guidelines and procedures this will be coming soon.

HEARD Facilities Director Reopening Report- We are making adjustment to the cleaning schedule for lunches with all the changes that have been made due to covid. We are painting the football field as football will be starting up.

HEARD Community Ed Directors Reopening Report- We have pictures scheduled for Preschoolers in November. We will have preschool screening on Friday of this week. ECFE classes are full. We are switching to a monthly flyer for community ed adult classes, please check out the website or look for these flyers around town.
